



Description: Head light
Part Number: 121050-121051
Application: 1994-1997 Honda Accord



Tools needed: Phillips
screwdriver, 5/16 hex key,
10mm socket, flex socket.



Step 1: Remove the phillips
screw to release the corner
light.



Step 2: take the corner light off.



Step 3: remove the two 10mm
screws for the headlight.



Step 4: Remove the phillips
screw holding in the grill and
remove the grill.



Step 5: Once the grill is off you
will expose the three screws
holding in the bumper and



Step 6: Remove the screw under
the corner light holding in the
bumper.



Step 7: Angle the headlight up
so you have room to remove the
other screws.



Step 8: Use the 10mm socket to
remove the bolt holding the
headlight housing.



Step 9: Use the 10mm wrench
to remove the next screw
holding in the headlight



Step 10: This screw you will
have to use the 10mm socket
with the flex socket to get the



Step 11: Once all screws from
the headlight remove the two
screws from under the



Step 12: Remove the four screws underneath the bumper.



Step 13: Remove the screw on the inside wheel well to take off the bumper.



Step 14: Remove the 5/16 hex screw to take off the bumper reinforcement bar.



Step 15: Remove the headlight harness and take off the headlight.



Step 16: Remove the corner light bulbs from the harness.



Step 17: Splice the two red wires (1 power; 1 ground) into the parking corner light for the



Step 18: Plug in the head light wire harness.



Step 19: Now plug in the corner light bulbs into the new Anzo light.



Step 20: Bolt the headlight on and reassemble the bumper back on.



Step 21: Test all functions before driving.
